Backstory

Charlie was born and raised in Montreal, Quebec Canada until the age of 13. It was at this time that her parents decided to move them back to her mother's home country of France. She was not happy about the idea at first but grew to love it the more she got to know the maternal side of her family. Their life was quiet there. They lived on the generational property in one of the original houses that had been refurbished by her grandparents only 5 years prior, having been a rental property for travellers wanting a quieter setting.

Charlie's mother, Alice, was born and lived in France for most of her life. This was until after she married Charlie's father, Marco, and became pregnant with Charlie. They decided to move to Canada for more career opportunities so Marco could try and get established in his preferred field of work. Something he had great success in doing after starting his own business, which quickly grew to be one of the biggest companies worldwide. He would eventually sell $\frac{3}{4}$ of the business for more than 30 million dollars in 1998, and still receives a minimum net income of 10 million dollars a year; much of which he donates to charities on a global scale.

Using the money from her grandfather, Charlie decided to move back to Canada for schooling. Moving to Toronto, ON, she attended the University of Toronto. And this is where she would meet Valorie Bowman, also 19 at the time. She was known as a bit of a wildcard and came from a super rich background of generational wealth. They met their first day of classes and immediately became close and started dating 3-months later. They would date all the way through college, and after graduation, at the age of 23, they would tie the knot.

Two months after the wedding, Charlie announced to the families that she was pregnant. Several months before the wedding, Charlie and Valorie had asked Valorie's brother, Nathaniel, if he would be willing to donate his sperm. They wanted to use one of Charlie's eggs along side his sperm to have a baby that was entirely related to them.

They had wanted to go to stores that neither Charlie nor Marcus had any interest in going to. So, they had split up so they could do the things they preferred.

Charlie and Marcus had been hit by the shockwave of the blasts, and only received cuts and bruises. Though it did not take long for Charlie to learn that Valorie and Bailey had been near the center of the blast, based on the location of the shops they were going to. However, it wasn't until 4 days later that their bodies were located and identified.

During the investigation, there were many things that did not make sense. There were many inconsistencies from the police, and the entire event was deemed an accident. However, Charlie did not believe that this was an accident, and neither did Valorie's family.
